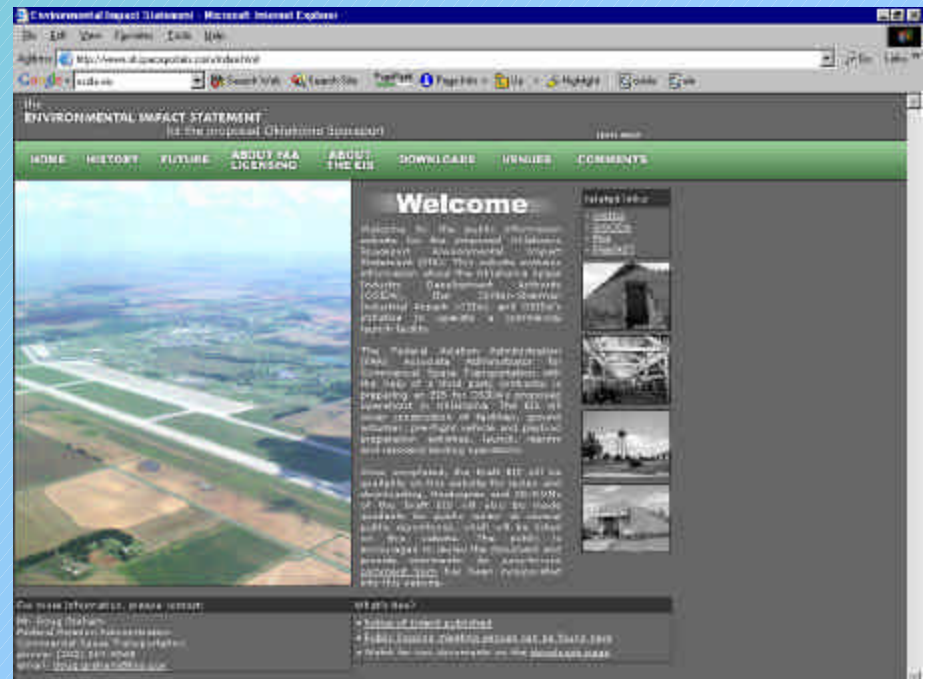


Administrative Points
